ARREST OF THE PROPRIETOR OF THE JOURNAL – Mr. Albert D. Boileau, the proprietor of the *Evening Journal* of this city, was arrested last night by the military authorities. The arrest was made upon an order from the War Department, but the charges against Mr. B. are not known. Mr. Boileau was taken to Washington. Mr. E. W. Carr, who is connected with the *Journal* establishment, was also arrested, but this morning was discharged by order of General Montgomery. The columns of the *Journal* have recently been filled with articles abusing the Government and bitterly denouncing the Administration, and it is probable that, to this fact, Mr. Boileau owes his sudden and involuntary visit to Washington.
