Pennsylvania Women and the Quest for Woman Suffrage

Excerpt from Dora Lewis letter to her mother, Mrs. Henry Kelly, Feb. 2, 1920

Dearest Mother,

... Louise is with us and Helen returns tonight from her Bryn Mawr reunion. The baby has been lovely. . . . Louise is leaving tomorrow for Phila. and I for Annapolis. The legislature convenes tomorrow at 8. New Jersey will probably vote tomorrow on ratification, and if she votes right it will help here enormously, if she doesn't I think Maryland will be about as difficult to win as one could imagine. However it is looking better than it did 2 weeks ago and if we can get all the work done in the men's home districts that should be done, I think we have a chance. . . .
