

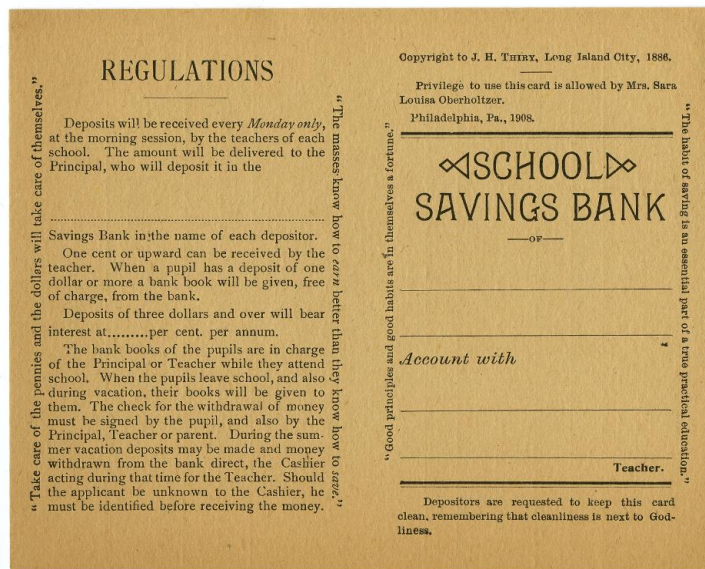
Sara Oberholtzer
