

The Number of What is Killed and Captivated in Bethel Township, Lancaster County, 1755-1757 Transcription

Introduction

The French and Indian Wars lasted several years was brutal and bloody. Lives were lost on both sides. The account below, chronicled by a soldier, not only lists the names of settlers killed in a particular region of the country, but also the number of persons that were made captive by the Indians.
