Knights of the Golden Eagle

Founded in 1873 by John Emory Burbage, the Knights of the Golden Eagle is a fraternal organization with rituals based on those of the crusaders. Members pass through three stages: pilgrim, knight, and crusader. In addition to giving moral and intellectual guidance, the society provided relief to sick or unemployed members and gave survivor benefits to widows and orphans. In 1900 the Knights of the Golden Eagle had approximately 20,000 members and functioned in twenty states. The society's motto is "Fidelity, Valor, and Honor," and rituals reflect the emphasis placed on the word of the Bible. The Knights of the Golden Eagle currently have approximately 2,000 members in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Delaware. The female auxiliaries are known as "Ladies of the Golden Eagle."

Knights of Pythias

The Knights of Pythias, founded in 1864 by Justus H. Rathbone, was the first American order to receive a charter by an act of Congress. The society has lodges in the United States and Canada and at one point had nearly half a million members. The society's motto is "Friendship, Charity, and Benevolence," and it gets its name from the story of Damon and Pythias, Greek youths who were bound to one another by loyalty and friendship, each of whom was willing to die for the other. The Knights of Pythias seek to practically apply the lessons taught in the Bible to everyday life.

Independent Order of Odd Fellows

The Independent Order of Odd Fellows was begun in England in the 17th century. In 1819 Thomas Wildey instituted the Washington Lodge No.1 in Baltimore, which was the first IOOF lodge in America. Rebekah Lodges, the female auxiliary of the IOOF, were founded in 1851 when a proposal known as "The Rebekah Degree" was adopted. "The Rebekah Degree" was written by Schuyler Colfax, who later became Vice President of the United States during the Grant administration. The name "odd fellows" supposedly dates back to the Order's early days in England, when it was considered peculiar to take part in mutual assistance societies. The Order places a strong emphasis on relief for sick or destitute. In 1872 the Order became the first fraternal organization to create special homes for elderly members and orphaned children.
