**Abstract**

The White-Williams Scholars serves needy and talented students in the Philadelphia schools. It is one of the oldest charitable organizations in the country, founded in 1800 as the Magdalen Society of Philadelphia (Magdalen Society of Philadelphia Records are maintained separately as Collection 2016). The organization shifted its focus in 1917 from rehabilitation to prevention of delinquency. It provided counseling in the schools, and training for counselors, as well as financial assistance. Eventually, the school district took over the responsibility for counseling. In 1918, the organization changed its name to the White-Williams Foundation to honor two of the original founders, Bishop William White and George Williams. The name changed again in 1994 to White-Williams Scholars, as it is known today, to recognize the current mission of supporting high-achieving secondary school students with weekly stipends.

The collection includes administrative and financial records. There are volumes of Board of Trustees and Annual Meeting minutes and reports covering the period 1917 to 1960, as well as a set of scholarship accounting ledgers from 1924 to 1982. There are also files documenting bequests and other contributions, and employee records. About two-thirds of the collection is school and student files that contain personal and family information, income data, and academic records for the students who received financial support from the late 1970s through 2001. Because of the personal nature of these files, access is restricted for seventy-five years from the date of creation.

**Background note**

The roots of the White-Williams Scholars date to 1800 and the founding of the Magdalen Society by a group of prominent Philadelphians, including Bishop William White, the first Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania, and George Williams, a Quaker merchant. As the Magdalen Society, its objective was to help “unhappy females who have been seduced from the paths of virtue and are desirous of returning to a life of rectitude.” By 1917, the city courts had assumed many of the functions of the Magdalen Society, and the organization sought a new focus. Recalling the 1849 comments of George Williams, then the 81-year-old board chairman, that prevention of delinquency was as important as the treatment, the organization was redirected, and in 1918, renamed the White-Williams Foundation for Girls.

Initially, the White-Williams Foundation directed its attention to girls leaving school to join the work force. Working with the Bureau of Compulsory Education, which issued the required working certificates, the White-Williams Foundation provided career counseling and job search advice to help the girls find employment in roles that matched their interests and abilities, and that offered safe and long-term opportunities. At times, girls, and their families, were advised that remaining in high school was the best alternative, and if necessary, White-Williams would provide stipends, or scholarships, to offset the financial impact of foregoing employment. In 1920, the words “for Girls” were officially dropped from the organization’s name, as assistance was offered to boys, as well.

Anna B. Pratt, hired in 1916, led the work to determine the new focus, and was the first director of the White-Williams Foundation, a position she held until her death in 1932. Pratt brought experience and vision to the organization. The early counseling was expanded to address younger children, and counselors were placed in elementary schools, addressing mental and physical health issues, including nutrition. These counselors were also known as “visiting teachers.” In addition, White-Williams offered fellowships for teachers to be trained in school counseling. Edith M. Everett, who led the Department of Counseling and Training, and later was Assistant Director, succeeded Pratt, and continued the White-Williams Foundation’s leadership in developing the school counseling function.

In 1942, the Board of Public Education assumed the responsibility for school counseling, and the White-Williams counselors were transferred to the control of the schools. White-Williams shifted emphasis from counseling to its other service of providing scholarship stipends.

In 1994, the name was changed again to White-Williams Scholars to more accurately describe the organization’s primary mission of supporting and encouraging high-achieving students. White-Williams works in partnership with school counselors who screen and advise applicants. Qualified students receive stipends of \$12 to \$18 weekly (in 1998-99), for transportation, lunches, school supplies, activity fees, SAT exams, or other purposes. Students must maintain grades of all A’s and B’s in major subjects, must display good citizenship, and must prove financial need.

Funding for student stipends comes from White-Williams’ endowment income and other donations. Some organizations provide funds annually to support a worthy student or students. In addition, funds are received through the United Way and an annual mail appeal.

In 1928, 152 students received scholarship support from White-Williams. By 1998-99, 1,400 students received aid. Financial resources influence the number of students, and the number of schools, that can be served. In the past, students from elementary and middle schools, as well as parochial schools, and even some private schools, have at times received stipends. Since 1998, however, the program has been limited to Philadelphia residents in grades 9 to 12 enrolled in public high schools. With the recent

volume of applications, some applicants are approved, but must wait for funds to become available before receiving a stipend.

White-Williams Scholars also works in partnership with the Charles Ellis Trust, which provides grants to girls from single parent families to assist them in completing high school. The Ellis Trust dates from 1909 when it established a school for fatherless girls. The school was closed in the 1970s. Since 1995, White-Williams Scholars has been contracted to handle the review of applications, and the award decisions for the Ellis Trust.

## Scope & content

The White-Williams Scholars Records include administrative and financial records of the organization itself, as well as school and student files of the young people the organization has served, and continues to serve. The organizational records predominantly cover the first sixty years of existence from 1918 to the late 1970s. The school and student files cover the recent time, from 1979 to the present. At least some of the earlier case records are gone. The chronology in Manual Book 1 (page 89) indicates that in 1942 the White-Williams counseling records up to 1932 were destroyed.

The volumes of minutes and reports provide a record of the organization's efforts to reinvent itself from the Magdalen Society, and to repeatedly shift emphasis as needs changed, while maintaining its mission of service to Philadelphia youth. Manual Book 1 provides a concise summary, including a narrative history of the early years, 1918 to 1929, as well as a detailed chronology from 1800 to 1942. Some examples of White-Williams publications are taped in the appropriate pages of the chronology. The financial records are varied, but the collection is incomplete with different records covering different periods of time. For example, the cash books run from 1921 through 1984, journals cover 1934 through 1968, and tax returns from 1950 through 1978.

The student files, which are from a period of twenty-three years (1979 through 2001), provide information on the type of students that have been supported. Many were relatively recent immigrants. Others came from single parent homes. Some students lived in foster homes, or with friends. Some were living independently. Some had children of their own. One reported being from a family of 22 children, most adopted, and many with special needs. Observation of the files suggests an increasing number and percentage of students with Hispanic, and especially, Asian heritage. Some students received stipends all four years of high school. Others applied for one or two years because of a change in circumstances. School counselors usually noted applications that were responding to new situations and required urgent handling. Grade reports accounted for a large portion of the student files. Grades were monitored, and a significant number of students were dropped from the program because of low grades. At the same time, some recipients appeared to be the top students in their schools, and reported winning scholarships to highly ranked private and public colleges.

In 1998-99, Dr. Margaret Beale Spencer, of the Center for Health, Achievement, Neighborhood, Growth and Ethnic Studies (CHANGES) at the University of

Pennsylvania, and a 1962 White-Williams alumna, began collecting information for the first formal evaluation of the White-Williams Scholars Program. No study-related information is included in the collection, however the consent form, which is part of the White-Williams Scholars Application, is in many recent student files.

The student files usually include an annual questionnaire. The questionnaire for graduating seniors is more comprehensive, and typically includes comments and, at times, suggestions, on the scholarship program. Some comments provided were, “It gave me a goal for my grades and pushed me to work harder,” and “It makes you feel like your (sic) part of a great family.” Another student wrote, “It is an honor, but it also means I have to work harder to keep the scholarship.” However, not all the comments were positive. One student wrote that he felt “degraded since it’s for poor kids.” A number of students wrote in terms of repaying a debt. One wrote, “I’m eternally grateful to the White-Williams Foundation for their encouragement over the last four years. Hopefully, I can do the same for a deserving student in the future.”

## Series description

### Series 1. Administrative, 1800-1999, n.d. (Boxes 1-21)

#### a. Organization, 1800-1988, n.d.

This subseries includes information on the founding of the organization, including the initial Act of Incorporation and subsequent amendments, as well as the petition from 1918 to change the name from The Magdalen Society to the White-Williams Foundation. The organization's objectives and miscellaneous information regarding members of the Board of Trustees are also parts of this subseries.

#### b. Minutes and Reports, 1800-1960, n.d.

The Minutes and Reports subseries includes fifteen volumes that document the formal meetings of the White-Williams Foundation from 1917 through 1960. Two volumes entitled Manual Books are especially noteworthy. Manual Book 1 contains the early history of the organization and a chronology from 1800 to 1942. The chronology section includes copies of newspaper articles and numerous White-Williams publications. Manual Book 2 contains organizational structure and responsibilities, counseling procedures, office staff roles, and sample forms. The minutes and reports contained in folders are largely duplicates of the records in the volumes.

#### c. Scholarship Reports, 1921-1999, n.d.

This subseries includes reports on the scholarship work of the White-Williams Scholars. Some of the earlier (pre-1942) information covers counseling activity as well as the scholarships. Some lists of scholarship students and their post-high school plans are also included in this subseries. Only a few reports include any aggregate data about the number of scholarships or demographics of the recipients. There are also only a few reports of follow-ups with scholarship recipients after their school years.

#### d. Publicity and Publications, 1918-1986, n.d.

Many of the documents in this subseries are articles and talks by Anna B. Pratt, the first executive director of the White-Williams Foundation, and Edith M. Everett, who succeeded Pratt in that position. Many of the talks are dated, but few include information on the purpose, event, or audience. There are also some articles by other White-Williams staff members. There are two volumes in the subseries. One contains newspaper articles about the organization from 1918 to 1924. The other contains occupational monographs published by White-Williams, and used in its early counseling work. In addition, there are a transcript and two audiotapes of a 1970 television interview.

#### e. Employees, 1917-1981, n.d.

This subseries includes information about the employees of White-Williams Scholars. Most records are salary, or payroll-related, some of which are from card files. This subseries also contains biographical information and one photograph of Anna B. Pratt.

f. General Files, c.1920-1985, n.d.

This subseries includes general administrative files, such as calendars, committee records, and procedures. An undated School Counselor Manual, and a report of staff questions and suggestions are part of the subseries. General files on the Better Business Bureau and Social Security are also part of this subseries.

g. Correspondence, 1948-1989

The Correspondence subseries is a small part of the collection. The Gratwick correspondence contains letters reporting on a series of school visits. Correspondence is also included in the Financial Series in folders regarding contributions and estates, trusts and memorial funds. Some of the more recent administrative correspondence with school counselors is in the school and student files.

h. Artifact, 1926

This subseries consists of one artifact, a medal from the Sesqui-Centennial International Exposition in Philadelphia in 1926.

**Series 2. Financial, 1912-1990 (Boxes 21-50)**

a. Contributions, 1919-1987, n.d.

The Contributions subseries includes files on various contributors to the White-Williams Scholars' general, and special, scholarship funds. In some cases, special funds were established to provide stipends for students with particular interests, backgrounds, or residences. For example, Club Tempo contributed to support a black female student. The Germantown Relief Society contributed funds designated for students living in the particular zip code areas of the Germantown section of Philadelphia. The files in this subseries typically contain correspondence, and in many cases, reports about the particular students receiving support from the special funds. The subseries also includes a volume with samples of annual appeal brochures and transmittal letters from 1919 to 1980.

b. Estates, Trusts, and Memorial Funds, 1912-1990, n.d.

This subseries includes files for various bequests to the White-Williams Scholars. Some are estates of former employees or board members. Some established special scholarship funds, while others supported the general fund. As with the Contributions subseries, the files contain correspondence, and at times, information about the students receiving aid.

c. Budgets, 1920-1966

This small subseries contains the budget documents for certain years, as well as papers that were contained in a file labeled, "Budget Notes."

d. Cashbooks, 1921-1984

This subseries consists of sixteen volumes. Fourteen provide a complete run of receipts and disbursements from 1921 through 1984. The other two volumes are records of petty cash transactions from 1922 to 1932.

e. Journals, 1934-1968

The Journals subseries is a set of five volumes, which cover the period December 1934 through September 1968.

f. Financial Statements, 1925-1987

This subseries includes three volumes of monthly trial balances from January 1945 through June 1987. This subseries also includes audited financial statements from 1944 through 1981.

g. Community Chest, 1946-1955

White-Williams Scholars received support from the Community Chest of Philadelphia & Vicinity, which later became the United Fund, or United Way. This subseries contains various financial reports that were filed with the Community Chest for the fiscal years 1946-47 through 1954-55.

h. Investments, 1935-1982

This subseries includes both formal reports from investment account managers and informal records of securities owned. The informal documents are hand-recorded, and those after 1956 are by individual security on forms labeled "Stockholder's Record." Each purchase and sale transaction, as well as the interest and dividend payments received, is recorded on a form for the specific stock or bond. There is a separate form for each security, and they are not aggregated by time period. Most of the formal investment reports are from Philadelphia National Bank. The reports from 1970 to 1979 provide separate results for the General Fund and the Amanda James Fund.

i. Ledgers, 1934-1988

The ledgers subseries includes ledger pages covering three time periods, 1924-1982, 1983-1984, and 1987-1988. The ledgers after 1982 seem incomplete.

j. Scholarship Accounting, 1924-1982

This subseries contains records documenting both contributions to scholarship funds and the payment of scholarship stipends from the funds. The largest portion of the subseries is a set of twenty-eight Scholarship Ledgers, which cover the period January 1924 through September 1982. For many years there are multiple records for scholarship accounting such as scholarship ledgers and control cards. These records seem to duplicate at least a portion of the scholarship information. It is not known who established and maintained the different types of records, or how they were used.

k. Tax Records, 1947-1978

This subseries includes copies of tax returns filed for most years from 1950 to 1978. Taxes were filed for fiscal years from July 1 to June 30. The records are arranged according to the year pre-printed on the tax forms, so July 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971 is the 1970 tax year. There are also records of payroll taxes withheld from employees from 1947 to 1968.

**Series 3. Scholarships, 1952-2001 (Boxes 51-166)- RESTRICTED**

a. Special Awards, 1952-1976

This subseries contains information about grants from the Amanda James Fund from 1952 to 1976. The information includes personal, family and financial details regarding the students recommended for these grants.

b. School and Student Files, 1979-2001

This subseries is the largest segment of the collection. It includes the scholarship applications, which contain family information, income records, grade reports, correspondence, and in some cases, photographs. The files are arranged by year, and by school alphabetically within year. The year is the graduating year. Thus the school year from September 1985 to June 1986 is considered "1986." The alphabetical arrangement by school is determined by the way each school is referenced by White-Williams. For example, Simon Gratz High School is referenced as "Gratz" and filed under "G." William Penn High School however, is referenced as "William Penn," and filed under "W." School folders include the student files for those students graduating in that year. The student files are arranged alphabetically within the school folder(s).

Most of the White-Williams Scholars records were received by HSP in good order. Many of the administrative and financial records are in volumes. Files were reviewed and duplicate papers were removed. Newspaper clippings and some other papers were photocopied for preservation purposes.

The bulk of the processing time was spent in reviewing the school and student files, which amount to 116 boxes of records. Paper clips, staples, and where possible, tape were removed from these files. Some records were photocopied for preservation purposes. Photographs were housed in polypropylene sleeves.

One volume, *How Foster Children Turn Out: A Study by the State Charities Aid Association*. New York, 1924 was removed from the collection.
