² Hannah Moore had endured brutal enslavement over the course of her life and had had six owners by the age of fifty-seven in 1854. In that year, she had stopped with her mistress, Mary Moore, in Philadelphia prior to boarding a ship for California where they were to meet Mary's husband. While in the city, Hannah was approached by an abolitionist who led her to members of the Vigilance Committee. They secured her release from Mrs. Moore and Hannah soon became legally free and a resident of Philadelphia. She found employment in an abolitionist household and became a devout member of the African Methodist Episcopal church in Philadelphia. She married Thomas Todd when she was about sixty years old. An extensive account of her time in slavery and after in Philadelphia is contained in Still, *Underground Rail Road*, 547-50.
