Scope and Content note

Francis James Dallett (1927-2007) was an archivist, genealogist, writer, and descendent of an old Philadelphia French family. He extensively researched the history of the French in Philadelphia. He also served for many years as an officer of HSP, and he collected ephemera regarding French-related activities and events, as well as documentation of French heritage in America.

These additions to the Dallett papers at HSP (Collection 3046) consist almost solely of Dallett's own family and genealogical research notes and correspondence, along with a smattering of original manuscripts that he collected. Material in boxes is roughly arranged by family name, among them Dallett, Atlee, Clarkson, Crossfield, Hemphill, Delapaine, Bringhurst, Chew, and dozens of others.
