Description

The Biddle Family Papers chiefly consist of five main series of papers; these include the papers of Charles Biddle, William S. Biddle, Nicholas Biddle, Charles J. Biddle, and Craig Biddle.

The papers for Charles Biddle (1745-1821) comprise one box. They deal largely with his land investments with Isaac Meason. These papers include Patents and Correspondence concerned with Western land speculation. Letters of interest include one from David Redick, August 18, 1796, on local and national politics and several from Catherine Edwards on family health, Yellow Fever, debts of her deceased husband, and the affects a possible French and Indian War might have upon American Merchants (June 25, 1803). Two folders in this box hold papers for his sons: Edward, who died in 1799 while sailing as midshipman for his brother James, and Richard (1796-1847), a highly distinguished lawyer and Representative in Allegheny County who was also involved in land purchasing.

The second series of papers are those of William S. Biddle, son of Charles and Hannah Sheppard Biddle. One box of this material is correspondence. The principle correspondents are Thomas and John Biddle. Issues discussed are national politics as well as local events for John in Detroit and Thomas in St. Louis. Later correspondence deal with the Bank of the United States and the fatal duel of Thomas Biddle with Spencer Pettis.

Following the correspondence is a small group of papers related to real estate -- particularly, a lot on Race Street. The remainder of the William S. Biddle Papers are legal papers for various family members. William S. Biddle acted as an attorney for his father; therefore, this section of papers includes accounts, indentures, stocks, bonds, bills, receipts, and promissary notes for Charles Biddle. Likewise, papers concerning his mother's estate, specifically the mortgages held by Hannah Biddle on Ware, Condy, and Evans, are among these papers. Accounts and correspondence for James Biddle (1783-1848) include letters from: George Bancroft, assigning him the Pacific Command in the War with Mexico; James Buchanan, on the China Mission; Martin Van Buren, in reference to the formation of a commercial treaty between the U.S. and the Sublime Porte for admission of the U.S. flag to the freedom of the Black Sea; and S.W. Kenny, on the transferral of Florida to Spain including all Archives and Documents. William S. Biddle and John C. Craig served as trustee for Jane Craig Biddle; some of these papers are found here. The papers for John Biddle (1792-1859) relate to his Congressional contest and miscellaneous papers such as receipts and a Bank book. William also had to answer the claim of Mary Biddle, a cousin, to her right to a share in the Race Street lot. The rest of the legal papers in the William S. Biddle series belong to Thomas and his wife, Ann. Thomas's papers include: receipts, bills of exchange, accounts as paymaster, 1819, 1830-1831, correspondence, aquisition of household furnishings, and his death. The papers for Ann Biddle are in settlement of Thomas's estate and her bereavement.

Twenty-seven boxes make up the third series of papers -- those belonging to Nicholas Biddle (1786-1844). Ten boxes of correspondence, 1801-1844, n.d., are arrange chronologically with the exception of the first two boxes. The first box is correspondence with William S. Biddle: 1800-1801, 1810-1812, 1815, 1817, 1822, 1834, n.d. dealing with family news and William's role in government -- especially mentioned are the Bank of the United States and the Loan and Conscription bills. The second box is correspondence with Jane Craig Biddle: 1811, 1814-1839, n.d. mostly of a social nature.

of the chronological correspondence range from local and national politics to private investments to private matters such as grape cultivation and construction at Andalusia. Correspondents include: A.J. Dallas and Edward Coles on banking; Robert and John Oliver on the Craig estate; R.L. Colt on the Bank of U.S. and land speculation; Thomas Biddle as land agent for Nicholas Biddle; B. DeHaert on Salt Spring, Montrose; one letter from James Monroe dated December 6, 1822; two letters from Davey Crockett dated October 7, 1834 and December 16, 1834 on the bank question and Crockett's election to office; Nicholas Biddle's sketch of intended letters on his relationship to the Bank of the United States and his views on the people in power in Washington, D.C. -- August, 1834; one letter from Daniel Webster dated January 7, 1840; one from Henry Clay dated December 20, 1840; George M. Dallas, William M. Meredith, John Read, E.R. Biddle, George M. Edwards, William Rawle, T.S. Taylor, and Henry Drinker on the Bank of the United States; Jno. McKinney and Henry D Rogers on the Buffalo Furnace; and one letter from Thaddeus Stevens dated June 25, 1842 on his relationship with the Court. box 7

Following the correspondence is one box of diaries, 1804-1807, 1810, n.d. covering his travels in Europe. BOX 15

Nicholas Biddle's legal papers comprise four boxes. Most of these papers deal with the Craig family. The bulk of the Craig family papers concern the Craig and McMurtrie land investments. Nicholas Biddle was attorney for John Craig, James Craig, John C. Craig, Ann Craig, Jane Craig Biddle, Janet Craig, and Margaret Craig. Also included in this legal section are files for Mary Biddle, Ann Backhouse, Miss Adele Sigoigne, Mrs Adele Sigoigne, and Catherine Sarmiento. The last box of legal papers concern the Russell Legal Case. BOX 10b

Following his legal papers are five boxes of papers dealing with investments and the Bank of the United States. Half of the papers on investments are real estate papers -- patents, surveys, mortgages, taxes, rental lists, lists of unseated lands. Some of these real estate transactions are with Samuel Hodgdon and later with the Pickering, Hodgdon and Coxe company. Other investments include: Biddle's partnership with Henry D. Rogers on the Buffalo Furnace, a lead mine, Baltimore and Port Deposit Railroad, Little Schuylkill Railroad and Navigation Company, Reading Railroad, Stony Creek Land Company, and the Commercial Bank of Manchester.

Among the Bank of the United States papers are: Isaac Bronson's plan for recharter, 1832, notes on speech by Daniel Webster, Special Committee on Assets and Liabilities, lists of loans, shareholders, accounts, stocks, memorandum, resolutions, Election of Directors, 1841, receipts and expenditures, lawsuits, Biddle's defense, and miscellaneous press items. Receipted bills, 1799-1844, n.d., fill two boxes. Another box of bank books, checks, and notes of protest finish out his financial papers. The remainder of the papers for Nicholas Biddle include a box of commonplace books, papers pertaining to Andalusia, one box of miscellaneous manuscripts, and, finally, printed materials such as newspaper clippings, Circular to Bankers, broadsides, and pamphlets. Thirty-one boxes incorporate the next series of papers for Charles J. Biddle (b.1819), son of Nicholas Biddle. Ten of these boxes are of correspondence: 1816, 1827, 1831-1873, 1882, 1883. Like the previous series, correspondence is arranged chronologically with the exception of the correspondence between Charles J. Biddle and Emma Biddle. These letters date ca. 1861-1863 and are of both personal and political nature. Most of the letters discuss his experiences in the House of Representatives and the geographical distance between them. Topics in the chronological correspondence involve his military and political careers. Included in these papers are letters dealing with his investments and various legal trusts.

Correspondents in these papers are: John Cadwalader on legal matters; Roswell L. Colt on salt works and land purchasing; A. B. Reed on Craig/McMurtrie lands; James Biddle, Thomas White, G.M. Dallas, and Henry Drinker, on the Mexican War; C.J. Ingersoll, Craig Biddle, Simon Cameron, William Seward (December 9, 1862) and James Buchanan (June 6, 1862) on political and military matters during the Civil War; George W. Woodward on Woodward's run for Governor and other matters concerning the Democratic party; and Benjamin Rush on the "Alabama" claims. George Meade, Thomas Hamilton, and A. G. Mercer are also among correspondents.

Charles J. Biddle's legal papers follow in eight boxes. Five of these boxes are family trusts. He handled affairs for: Ann Biddle, Charles Biddle, Edward Biddle, Hannah Biddle, James Biddle, James S. Biddle, Jane M. Biddle, Nicholas Biddle, Jane Craig (single woman), Catherine & Sydney Jones, Mary Sarmiento, Ann Craig, Jane J. Sarmiento Craig Biddle and John C. Craig. Papers for Jane J. Sarmiento Craig Biddle and, her son, John C. Craig are the bulk of the family trusts papers in three boxes. The rest of his legal files are miscellaneous cases which are filed alphabetically.

There is one box of real estate papers. They are primarily deeds with some financial statements and one field book of surveys by Jason Torrey of Pickering, Hodgdon, and Coxe. Two boxes contain military papers, for both the Mexican War and the Civil War, and some political papers, such as: speeches, resolutions, Senate bills (Compromise of 1850 and the Kansas-Nebraska Act), Pennsylvania Democratic Party papers, and the Woodward v. Curtin race.

Financial papers for Charles J. Biddle amount to two boxes of receipted bills, 1839-1862, n.d. and one box of checks and bank books. Miscellaneous papers, mostly concerning literary pursuits -- fictional writing, research on Washington and Major Andre, lists of books at Andalusia, and his work as editor of The Age, complete the manuscript section of the Charles J. Biddle series. Unsorted newspaper clippings finish out the series altogether.

The final series of papers belong to Craig Biddle (b.1823), youngest son of Nicholas Biddle. Like Nicholas and Charles J. Biddle, Craig Biddle studied law at Princeton College. He also had extensive military and political careers (with the Whig party) and later served as a Judge. His papers include legal and miscellaneous papers and receipts. There is also an indexed volume of Biddle and Craig Family letters, 1787-1825.

Not specifically part of the Craig Biddle series, but arranged at the end of the Biddle Family Papers are eleven miscellaneous volumes. They are: James Biddle's Log Book for U.S. "Ontario", 1817-1819; James Biddle's Journal, 1817-1819; James Biddle's Letterbook, 1829-1830; J. Craig Biddle's Index Rerum, 1840; J. Craig Biddle's book of Caricatures - re: U.S. Bank; Charles Craig Biddle's Scrapbook, 1825 (from his brother Edward); another Scrapbook on the U.S. Bank, 1835-1837; Craig Biddle's Scrapbook on the careers of Charles J. Biddle and Craig Biddle, 1847-1875; Craig Biddle's Scrapbook on the License Court, 1893-1898; J. Biddle's Music Book for the Harp; and Adele Biddle's Music Book for the Piano.
