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Abstract

This fraternal benefit society was established in Pittston, on June 24, 1893, as the Pennsylvania Slovak Roman and Greek Catholic Union (PSRGCU). In October 1954, the name of the organization was shortened to Pennsylvania Slovak Catholic Union (PSCU). The PSRGCU was born of necessity since injury or death compensation laws in the coal industry were not yet in existence. The Union was formed as a beneficial and insurance society, but also played cultural, and social roles. The Union, as a part of the Slovak-American ethnic community, contributed to the creation and preservation of parishes, religious orders, and newspapers. The PSCU had its home office in the City of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. In October 1990, the PSCU merged with the First Catholic Slovak Union of the United States and Canada (FCSU), which remains in existence in 2003. The FCSU's corporate headquarters are in Independence, Ohio.

The heart of the collection is membership applications, various insurance certificates and claims, and miscellaneous registers. Records of the PSCU also include constitutions and bylaws, convention minutes and reports, correspondence, official publications, administrative financial records, such as annual statements, general account ledgers, and expenses of supreme officers ledgers, and a great deal of membership financial records that include, in particular, income and expenses ledgers of the branches, membership dues books, check and cash registers, and claim ledgers. A few photographs, and one artifact finalize the collection.

Background note

The American immigration figures indicate the first important Slovak influx in 1873, when 1,300 immigrants came from Hungary. A cholera epidemic and subsequent widespread crop failures set in motion large-scale emigration from the eastern regions of Slovakia. This wave of emigration was also fueled by hardships connected with industrialization, the scarcity of available land, and a campaign of forced magyarization. At the same time, labor problems in the mining areas of Pennsylvania created a demand for new laborers. From 1871 to 1879, when the "Molly Maguires" were active in mining districts and practically ignored the authority of the State, the various coal companies determined to look abroad for foreign labor to replace their defiant workmen. The success of the first Slovak immigrants encouraged many of their countrymen to follow.

The Slovak immigration figures rose to 4000 in 1880, and to nearly 15,000 in 1884, many of them settling in the mining and industrial regions of Pennsylvania. The first benefit societies were organized (the First Hungarian-Slovak Sick Benefit Society was formed in New York in 1883).

The PSRGCU was organized during meetings on June 24-25, 1893, in a storeroom of the Francis Juskewicz Building, 68 Main Street, Pittston, Pennsylvania. Edmund Uffalussey was elected temporary chairman, and Joseph Kiesel was temporary secretary. Frank Oravec became the first president of this organization. The initial group of supreme officers included: Andrew Skvir, vice president; Vincent Kalman, Andrew Pavlik, and John Dugas, auditors. St. John the Baptist was chosen as the patron of the organization. The Reverend Matthew Jankola, pioneer Slovak priest and founder of the St. John the Baptist Slovak Catholic Church in Pittston, was elected the first spiritual advisor. The new organization had seven branches with 456 members. The St. Joseph's Society, which was established in 1885, became the PSRGCU's Branch #1.

As stated in the constitution and bylaws, the objects and purposes of the organization were charitable and benevolent, "to support of sick and disabled members, also to support those left after the deceased members," bury its deceased members, "to promote the moral, spiritual, and material welfare of all Slovaks or Slavonians of the Catholic Faith, either of the Roman or Byzantine rite," encourage the use of the Slovak language, perpetuate a spirit of ethnic pride, encourage the members to remain loyal and faithful to the United States, and assist in education of the members. The organization raised money through membership fees, subscriptions, fines, and dues from members for the purpose of accumulating a fund to defray the expenses of burial of deceased members or their relatives. In the early years the death benefit was set at \$500 for a male member, \$200 for a female, and \$225 for juvenile member. The association also provided benefits for accidents, total disability, and made mortgage loans.

In 1894, PSRGCU created nine new branches adding 344 members. In 1895, six additional branches with 200 new members joined the society. In 1902, the society numbered 85 branches with 4,473 members. In June 1903, the Juvenile Division of the society was organized by the initiative of Edmund Uffalussey. The number of branches and membership of the society increased in subsequent years. By 1909, there were 198 branches with 9,421 members. The branches helped extend the PSRGCU's religious and cultural contributions. In 1908, through the efforts of the St. John's Society (Branch # 131), which was organized on September 16, 1905, the first Slovak Church in Tresckow was built, and in 1925, a larger brick church was built. In 1916, the members of this branch organized their own Slovak band, which stood as a tribute to the love of musical culture amongst these early Slovak organizers.

On June 24, 1899, attendees of the 6th National Convention held in Pittston, voted to publish the official newspaper *Bratstvo*, which means Brotherhood. The first issue was published on August 3, 1899. The newspaper was published weekly at first, and from mid-1970s, on a monthly basis. Edmund Uffalussey was its first editor. Later, the managing editors of *Bratstvo* were Stephen J. Tkach, and from April 1979 to December 1981 – Stefan J. Kavulich. The well-known editor of the *Katolícky Sokol*, John C. Sciranka

also worked with *Bratstvo* publication many years. It was mailed to all active male members. Eight cents from the dues of active male members was contributed toward the publications. There was also an annual religious periodical, *Calendar Bratstvo*. Both *Bratstvo* and *Calendar Bratstvo* were in Slovak language. Starting in the mid-1950s, materials in *Bratstvo* were published in both Slovak and English. In the mid-1970s, the PSCU published its history in a 500-page book entitled *Slovaks in America - A Bicentennial Study*, compiled by Stephen J. Tkach and John C. Sciranka.

The PSCU owned two connected buildings in Wilkes-Barre, built in 1914. One was a commercial apartment building they rented out, which at first brought in a profit. From 1929 to 1974, the apartments were occupied by college students or were vacant because they were not improved and modernized. The *Bratstvo* printing department and the society business offices occupied the other building.

During the World War II more than two thousand members of the PSRGCU joined the armed forces, and sixty-nine died. The year 1943 was the golden jubilee of the PSRGCU, but at that time the nation was immersed in World War II and the jubilee was not celebrated. The postponed 50th anniversary was finally celebrated at the 29th Convention in 1950, in Hazleton.

In October 1954, the name of the organization was shortened to Pennsylvania Slovak Catholic Union (PSCU). The PCSU was an active member of the Slovak League of America, the Slovak Catholic Federation, and the Slovak World Congress. The society participated in many historically significant events and organized various celebrations. For example, in 1975 Holy Year was celebrated in Rome, and many organizations, including the PSCU, were called upon to organize a pilgrimage. In 1976, the PSCU participated in the U.S. Bicentennial events sponsored by the Slovak League of America in Philadelphia, including a Slovak Mass, banquet, parade, and patriotic celebration at Independence Hall. PSCU also participated in the 41st International Eucharistic Congress, which included a Slovak Mass at the Spectrum in Philadelphia, on August 7, 1976.

The income of the organization was initially allocated to a variety of specific funds. The Mortuary Fund consisted of regular monthly dues paid by each member according to age. The Reserve Fund received 2 cents from each member's monthly dues, interest on accumulated and invested assets, any surplus created in other funds, and the joining fee of 50 cents per member. Each male member paid 5 cents from dues to the Disability Fund. Orphans' accounts received the money placed to the credit of the orphans of the deceased members for which the Union acted as Trustee, and the benefits were held in trust until the child reached age 21. Once every two years each male member paid 25 cents to the Indigent Fund, to cover financial aid or assistance given arbitrarily to members in need. The Expense Fund was allocated 13 cents per month from each male member's dues, 5 cents was to cover administration expense, the remaining 8 cents to apply to the cost of printing the *Bratstvo*. Female members contributed 5 cents of dues, which was applied to the cost of administration. The Administration Fund also received 25 cents for each change of beneficiary, and 25 cents for each new certificate issued by the organization.

In January 1980, the society changed its method of bookkeeping. The adult and juvenile income and disbursements were placed into one fund on consolidated basis. Also, the Mortuary, Administration, Disability, and Building Funds were kept in the General Fund. The new system streamlined accounting practices.

The primary business of PSCU was always insurance. As of 1978, the organization's branches were licensed to provide insurance in Pennsylvania, Ohio, Michigan, Connecticut, New Jersey, New York, Illinois, West Virginia, and Indiana. However, the PSCU provided additional benefits to its members. After serious floods, such as the 1978 Johnstown Flood, and the Wyoming Valley Flood, the Society granted a \$50 donation to each family of active members affected by these natural disasters. In 1984, according to the financial committee report given to the convention, the society had paid nearly \$20,000,000 in insurance benefits to its members and beneficiaries, since its establishment.

From 1932, the society experienced a steady decline in membership. According to convention reports, in 1929 there were 22,954 members, but in 1932 — 21,547. This downward trend continued in subsequent years. By 1982, there were only 7,717 members in the society despite the initiation of pre-convention membership campaigns with increasing rewards and commissions.

Because of its dwindling membership, the PSCU began to seek a merger with another society. As early as in 1929, during the 23rd Convention in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, a merger with the First Slovak Catholic Union in Cleveland, Ohio, was proposed. In 1932, on the next convention in Detroit, Michigan, another merger was postponed. The merger issue was discussed during the subsequent years, and during the 1941 convention the Special Committee on Merger was organized. At that time, possible merger not only with the First Slovak Catholic Union, but also with Pennsylvania Ladies Slovak Roman and Greek Catholic Union (which was established in 1898, in Wilkes-Barre, with the PSRGCU's help), and with the Slovak Catholic Sokol, Passaic, New Jersey was debated. Again this idea appeared in 1978. Despite the interest in a merger the PSCU remained independent. Finally, in October 1990, the Society merged with the First Catholic Slovak Union of the United States and Canada (FCSU). The Society members became the members of the FCSU, and their insurance policies were transferred to the FCSU, which was still in existence in 2003. This collection dates to only 1986, and does not include any information about the FCSU's merger. An Appendix # 1 contains the names and membership figures of other existed Slovak mutual benefit societies.

Scope & content

This collection documents much of the PSCU's operations and is organized into four series: *Administrative*, *Membership*, *Other Organizations*, and *Photographs & Artifacts*. Materials in the collection dating prior to 1950 are mostly in Slovak. There are a few documents in Russian. The collection spans the years 1890 to 1986, with the bulk of the materials concentrated between 1902 and 1984. The collection provides a great deal of information about the various benefits and values of insurance plans and other vital data

relating to adult and juvenile certificates issued by the organization. The Appendix # 2 contains descriptions of the society's insurance plans.

The collection includes constitutions and bylaws from 1921 to 1982, near-complete sets of convention minutes from 1913 to 1982, and convention reports from 1909 to 1982. The level of detail in the minutes varies. The early minutes trace all convention proceedings, and include session records, reports, and resolutions, while others, particularly later minutes starting from 1969, include only reports of committees. The reports again vary in details, and are historically informative, reflecting the organization's financial status, comparative statistics, and business activities. At first the conventions were held each year. On the 1903 convention was determined to provide conventions every two years, on the 1932 convention was decided to have conventions every three years, and finally, from 1946, the conventions were held every four years.

A very small amount of correspondence covers the period from 1898 to 1984, with the bulk from 1913 to 1948. There is correspondence from the society members and their relatives, attorneys or other officials, which includes complaints, petitions, and requests pertaining to the disposition of insurance benefits, and inquiries regarding the death benefits, some times in the matter of lawsuits. Other letters provide additional information regarding a member's or a beneficiary's data. Included is also a 1914 Memorandum of the Slovak League of America concerning oppression of the Slovaks in Hungary. The small cluster of outgoing correspondence, and some bank correspondence also is included. The correspondence from the members to the conventions 1936-1938 contains requests for financial assistance. There is some correspondence from non-members applying for financial support as well. For example, there is a letter from the Mount Assisi Academy, which asked for financial support for rebuilding the Slovak Girls' Higher School. Included is also a register of correspondence between the national office and local branches from 1898-1901.

The collection contains a great deal of administrative financial materials. *Administrative Financial* records from 1916 to 1979 include an extensive run of Annual Statements from 1929 to 1979. These were filed with the Insurance Departments of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia. The Annual Statements detail the Society's investments, expenses, and assets, and provide information on membership admitted and transferred to senior membership. Other administrative financial records include general account ledgers, national trial balance, expense of supreme officers, building account ledgers, and the *Bratstvo* account ledger.

From June 1899, the society published the weekly newspaper *Bratstvo*. The only issue of the newspaper *Bratstvo* in this collection from February 1984 was transferred to the Library's newspaper collection. In 1909, the annual publication *Calendar Bratstvo* was established. *Calendar* was a Slovak religious periodical that included religious holiday calendars, programs of events, stories, plays, biographies and photographs of prominent people, and scriptural materials in a 200-page pamphlet. The collection includes eleven issues of the *Calendar* from 1911 to 1925, excluding issues from 1912, 1920, 1921, and 1923. It is unclear whether this publication lasted beyond 1925.

The largest portion of the collection is the *Membership* series, which comprises 103 boxes. The series is divided into four subseries: *Registers and Lists*; *Financial*; *Applications, Certificates, and Claims*, and *Local Branches Minute Books*. The bulk of these materials covers the period from 1905 to 1980. The registers and lists include branch registers, master listings, group registers, attained age registers, and deceased members' life cards with names, addresses, and phone numbers. There are alphabetical indexes of members in some of these registers that facilitate locating members' records. The great deal of financial membership materials are membership ledgers, ledgers of income and expenses, cash disbursements for Senior and Junior Orders, extensive runs of dues books from identified and unidentified branches, orphans' account ledgers, claim ledgers, cash receipts, check registers, monthly reports, and assessments.

The heart of the *Membership* series is *Applications, Certificates, and Claims* subseries. This subseries includes various members' applications, certificates, and policies for both the Adult or Senior Division (or Order), and Juvenile/Junior Division (or Order), covering the years 1909-1985, and the Orphans' Account Claims covering 1890 to 1930. These documents give the researcher some familiarity with types of insurance certificates issued by the PSCU and trace the society's membership movement. From these documents the researcher could also determine members' personal and some genealogical information. Membership statistics regarding particularly religion and ages also are feasible. Additionally, motives of members' leave the society could be defined from extensive inactive applications.

Also extensive in this subseries are orphans' account claims and cash surrender policies. The inactive applications belonged to the lapsed members from both adult and junior membership from 1922 to 1960, excepting 1943. There are death certificates from 1909 to 1915. Some membership documents were originally in envelopes that often also held correspondence and other certification, which remain attached. There are registers and ledgers to facilitate access to the claims and certificates, if the certificate or claim number, or the entry date of certificate, or the date the claim was filed, is known.

The collection includes materials of a few other organizations, primarily the National Fraternal Congress of America and the Pennsylvania Fraternal Congress. These papers include, particularly, the National Fraternal Congress of America annual conventions' transactions, annual reports, programs, printed, and reference materials. The collection includes ten black and white photographs, mostly imaging groups of unidentified men. One artifact, which finalizes the collection, is a metal embossed sign with the organization's name abbreviation in Slovak letters, PSRGKJ.

Series description

Series 1. Administrative, 1898-1984, n.d. (Boxes 1-14)

a. Constitution and bylaws, 1921-1982.

This subseries consists of printed brochures of the PSCU's constitution and bylaws, from 1921 to 1982, with some gaps. There is also one typed draft of the constitution, and a scrapbook with drafts of bylaws and original brochure pages. Included is a brochure entitled *Legal Advice*, which was published in 1930 by the PSCU *Bratstvo* Printery in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, as compliments from PSCU. The author of the brochure was Peter P. Jurchak, the General Counsel of the PSCU.

b. Convention minutes and reports, 1909-1982.

The minutes and reports are published, except for 1938, which are typed draft pages. The convention minutes are from 1913 to 1982. Of note is a near-complete run from 1909 to 1982 of printed supreme officers' convention reports. Minutes and reports dating prior to 1950 are mostly in Slovak, while the latest convention materials are written primarily in English, with some Slovak.

c. Correspondence, 1898-1984.

There is a small amount of mostly incoming correspondence, from 1898 to 1984. This consists of requests, complains, and inquiries regarding insurance benefits status, and the correspondence from members and non-members to the 1936 and 1938 conventions, including petitions for financial support.

d. Agreements and certificates, 1905-1947.

This subseries includes a memorandum of agreement between the PSCU and Edmund Uffalussey in which Uffalussey was assigned "to be the Editor and Publisher of the *Bratstvo*, a weekly newspaper published at Wilkes-Barre, Penna., and the recognized official organ of the said Union." This agreement "shall take effect from July 1, 1905, and continue until the date of the next convention of the said

Union.” Another agreement was established in 1929 between PSCU and Josef J. Kotulak of Nanticoke, Pennsylvania, regarding repairs of the PSCU’s apartment and printing buildings, located at North Main and North Streets in Wilkes-Barre. This agreement includes the specifications for the buildings’ alteration and repairs, including labor to be performed and material to be furnished. There are also 1926 deposit agreements established by PSCU with different banks, as well as applications from 1947 for company licenses, which define classes of insurance and specify the states of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Indiana, Ohio, Illinois, and West Virginia, as areas where the organization’s branches were licensed.

e. Financial, 1916-1979.

Administrative financial records include annual statements, general account ledgers, national trial balance, expenses of supreme officers’ ledgers, building account ledgers, and the *Bratstvo* account ledger.

f. Publications, 1911-1925.

This subseries contains eleven issues of the annual publication *Calendar Bratstvo* from 1911 to 1925. The issues from 1912, 1920, 1921, and 1923 are not included. The only issue of the newspaper *Bratstvo* in this collection, which was from February 1984, was transferred to the Historical Society of Pennsylvania Library’s newspaper collection.

g. Reports, 1927-1937, n.d.

This subseries includes insurance examination reports from 1927, 1929, and 1937, as well as the 1928 valuation report for the Juvenile Division. An undated report of the Special Committee on Mergers, presumably from 1941, contains a proposal for the merger of existing small fraternal benefit societies in several states and Canada into a larger society. In this report, the Pennsylvania Ladies Roman and Greek Catholic Union of Wilkes-Barre is mentioned as a potential society for merger, since the organization consisted of the mothers, wives, sisters, and daughters of the members of the PSRGCU.

h. Instructions and Manuals, 1949-1953, n.d.

This is a small part of the *Administrative* records, and includes a 1949 Rate Book and Manual that gives information about application and certificate formats and purposes, and defines insurance classes and rates. There are two booklets with content similar to the rate book, and an *Explanation of Certificate Rewriting* brochure.

Series 2. Membership, 1890-1986 (Boxes 14-116)

a. Registers and lists, 1893-1986.

Membership registers represented in this subseries include two volumes, one of which spans the years 1893-1898, and another — 1928-1930. A branch register covers the period from 1909 to 1915. There are also master listings, which are computer print out sheets that contain information tracking the member’s age status, insurance becoming fully paid or maturing, and extended terms. All listings are in table format, and include the following fields: “Internal coding,” “Branch number,”

“State code,” “Member’s name,” “Certificate number,” “Year of birth,” and “Amount of insurance and premium.”

Group registers give information about the number of members and amount of insurance for each age group. These registers have tables with fields such as “Entry age,” “Monthly new-increase-reinstated certificates,” “Total before termination,” “Terminations (expelled-death-decrease),” “Total terminations,” and “Net number of members and amount in force.” There is information on the top-right corner of each sheet showing the insurance plan, and there are tabs on the right side of the sheets with this information as well.

Attained age registers are tabular sheets with information about dates of new issues and cancellations. The registers also include the number and amount of the insurance certificates for certain ages from 16 to 97 for each insurance plan and year.

b. Financial, 1902-1982.

The bulk of this subseries is ledgers documenting membership, and income and expense ledgers that contain information about financial operations of the branches. The branches, however, are not always identified. There are also dues books from identified and unidentified branches. There is little information regarding the finances of the Orphans’ Account, and the Junior Order Account. Unpaid claims account books for 1910-1915 include information regarding the death claims and matured endowments, which were not paid because the documents presented by claimants were incomplete in accordance with requirements.

The claim ledgers were originally numbered from 1 to 13 and one book was unnumbered. They span the years from 1915 to 1978. The claim ledgers contain an index. The claims are listed in chronological order as the recorded documents were filed. The claim number is located in the upper right-hand corner of the member’s entry. These books have an alternative format on microfilm.

Senior and Junior Orders cash disbursement ledgers cover the period from 1916 to 1980. A cash receipts volume covers the period from 1916 to 1930, while cash receipt sheets span from 1962 to 1979, leaving a significant gap in these documents. The check registers are incomplete. It was difficult to decipher funds and accounts of the most part of these registers and they were sorted by banks. Others are arranged by accounts and funds, but many of them remain unidentified. This sub-series also includes a few monthly reports and assessment sheets.

c. Applications, Certificates, and Claims, 1890-1985.

This subseries is the largest and has great research value, because of depth and breadth of the membership information it contains, and presenting a variety of documents pertaining to insurance.

Applications for membership are divided into two groups: Junior Order Membership Applications, 1923-1946; and Applications for Juvenile and Junior Membership, 1953-1958. This arrangement reflects the original order. Applications provide

information on the member, spouse's name, and religious affiliation. These applications are arranged chronologically and then by branch number within that arrangement.

Applications for Benefit Certificate are medical and non-medical. The applications are from 1950 to 1974, and consist of a small group of membership records, arranged chronologically. These documents may also be found as attachments among other types of membership insurance documents in subseries II c.

The large group of inactive applications from 1922 to 1956, with the exception of those from 1943, contains records of members who were expelled or voluntarily gave up membership. Several of the Juvenile Division members' applications are included in these records. The most common reason for leaving was unwillingness or inability to make dues payments. The applications are organized by year/month, and then by branch number.

Benefit Certificates and Requests for Exchange, from 1952 to 1975, is a small and incomplete run of membership records with gaps from 1954 to 1958, and from 1959 to 1971. Most of these documents are requests to exchange old juvenile term certificates. The arrangement is chronological.

Only a few documents comprise the extended insurance expired group. In accordance with the terms and provisions of the certificates and because a member had made no choice of cash value, paid insurance, or extended insurance, the certificate was converted to expired extended term insurance. The member received a warning notification. These documents cover 1972 to 1984, and are arranged chronologically.

Expelled policies are also chronologically arranged, covering 1945 to 1984 with some gaps. This group of expelled policies differs in format and content from expelled inactive applications.

Cash surrender policies cover 1966-1985 with some gaps. The information, based on these papers, could provide statistics on the amount of cash paid out on surrendered policies in any given year.

Mortgage Applications for Insurance, 1932-1952, are organized chronologically and specify the mortgagers' names. In the mid-1970s, the Society ceased granting mortgage loans.

There are Group Life Policies of Metropolitan Life Insurance, Co., 1919-1920 that include lists of checks in settlement of death claims.

The group of miscellaneous applications and certificates, 1930-1972, which do not fit the established categories, includes the following records: applications for extended benefit options; applications and agreement for certificate loan; non-medical and

medical transfer applications from Junior to Senior Orders; designation or change of beneficiary applications; and dues loan agreements.

Death certificates are from 1909 to 1915. There are also a few marriage certificates attached to the death certificates.

Orphans' account claims span dates 1890-1930. Arrangement is by branch number, then alphabetically by last name. These records often include correspondence, miscellaneous certificates, and checks. There are related Orphans' Account Claim Registers in series II a. There are also a few baptism certificates from 1890 and 1891.

There are microfilmed files of death claims (#1-#19,187) on 117 reels that have been transferred to the HSP Library's microfilm collection.

d. Local branches minutes, 1906-1960

There are minute books from four branches, one of which is unidentified. Minute books cover 1906 to 1960, but the span of years for each branch is different.

Series 3. Other Organizations, 1922-1969 (Boxes 117-118)

a. Annual conventions, meetings, reports, and souvenir programs, 1930-1969.

This series includes materials of the National Fraternal Congress of America and the Pennsylvania Fraternal Congress. There are some Annual Reports of the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance, and Commissioner of Insurance of the State of New Jersey; the Insurance Commissioner of the State of West Virginia; and the Department of Insurance of the State of Indiana. Also included are: a souvenir program of the American Slovak Day sponsored by the United Slovak Organizations and Societies of Cleveland and Lakewood; a program of the Eighteenth Annual Banquet of the American Slovak Society of Lackawanna and Susquehanna Counties; and a souvenir book of the 27th Convention of the Ladies Pennsylvania Slovak Catholic Union.

b. Printed and reference materials, 1922-1946

There are a few printed materials probably used by PSCU as information resources such as analysis of coal mine accidents in Pennsylvania from 1916 to 1920; a Slovak book review, published and printed by Slovak League of America; insurance law research studies concerning beneficiaries' rights, and mortgages.

Series 4. Photographs and Artifacts, n.d. (Box 118)

There are ten black and white photographs included in this collection. They are undated, and show unidentified groups of men, presumably some of the organization's members, and Hudak's Market building. There is also one artifact, which is a blue embossed metal sign with "PSRGKJ" emblem, entitled "Member Pennsylvania Slovak Union" in yellow reflective material. The "PSRGKJ" is the abbreviation for PSRGCU in Slovak letters.

Appendix 2

Descriptions of the PSCU's insurance plans

As stated in the Rate Book and Manual, there were four forms of Adult Certificates: Ordinary Life Certificates; 20 Year Endowment Certificates; Endowment at Age 65 Certificates; and 20 Year Payment Life Certificates. The following describes these insurance plans.

Under the Ordinary Life (from the age of 16 to 55) insurance plan the amount of the certificate was payable to the beneficiary in the event of death whenever that event occurred. This kind of insurance provided the largest amount of protection for the lowest cost. The 20 Year Endowment Certificate was a combination of savings and insurance protection. The PSCU's member paid his dues over a period of 20 years and at the end of that time, the PSCU guaranteed the member or the beneficiary the amount of the certificate. The Endowment at Age 65 insurance provided for payment of the

amount of certificate to the member or beneficiary when the member paid dues until age 65. The 20 Year Payment Life insurance was similar to the ordinary life insurance, except that the member paid dues for only 20 years. At the end of that time the member was insured for the remainder of his lifetime for the certificate amount.

After paying dues for three years or more, a member was entitled to a surrender value in the event of suspension or voluntary withdrawal from the organization.

Any child of Slovak Roman or Greek Catholic descent, from birth to age 16, was eligible for insurance benefits under any of the underwritten plans of the Junior Division. At the age of 16 the child automatically transferred to the Adult Division. The various plans of insurance were as follows:

Class 1—Term Insurance to age 18 for an ultimate amount of \$500.

Class 2—Term Insurance to age 16 for an ultimate amount of \$1,000.

Class 3—Whole Life issued from age 0 to 16 for an ultimate amount of \$1,000.

Class 4—20 year Payment Endowment at age 85, issued from ages 0 to 16 for an ultimate amount of \$1,000.

Class 5—20 year Endowment issued from ages 0 to 16 for an ultimate amount of \$1,000.

Class 6—Educational Endowment at age 18, issued from ages 0 to 9 for an ultimate amount of \$1,000.
