- Then some fanatics here & there who carry out
their views, would or soon have our throats cut as we
- but the North as a body are the righteous friends and
brothers of the South - but you cannot make people

of the North, get up meetings & denounce this abolition foray
& let the proper men see that they are not mere papists

spectator of such movements as this, John Brown

He is only a type of his class of incendiary killers
who would burn our houses, and murder us all
